ONLY PLAINS TOWNSHIP TRASH BAGS WILL BE COLLECTED BY MUNICIPALITY. There is a four bag limit. BAGS MUST BE TIED & WEIGH 40 LBS OR LESS.-PLEASE REVIEW-IF THESE GUIDELINES ARE NOT FOLLOWED. YOUR RECYCLABLES WILL NOT BE COLLECTED. RECYCLABLES MUST BE CLEAN & AT CURBSIDE BEFORE 6:00 A.M. IN A REUSABLE CONTAINER. The following recyclables will be collected: plastic with number 1 or 2 recyclable symbols; CLEAN green, brown or clear glass jars & bottles & tin & aluminum cans; & newspapers tied or in a container. **Cardboard must be flattened & tied or in a container.** Newspapers in plastic bags will **not** be collected. If dirty or unacceptable items are placed in the curbside container, the ENTIRE container will be left at curb. Workers will not return to pick up these containers. We MUST enforce these regulations to continue to provide this free service. Miss your pickup day? The drop off site (at the top of Blanchard Street) is open M-F 7-1:30 for recyclables ONLY!

CO-MINGLED ITEMS

A mix of plastic bottles, aluminum and steel (tin) cans, and glass. All lids, caps, and tops should be removed. All containers should be rinsed out.

Accepted:

- **Plastic** – PET and HDPE plastics
Soda bottles, plastic milk containers, water bottles, laundry detergent bottles, bleach bottles, shampoo bottles, etc.
- **Cans** – Aluminum and Steel (Tin) Cans
Food and Beverage cans: Soda, pet food, vegetable, fruit, juice, coffee, etc.
- **Glass** – Clear, brown, and green bottles and jars.

Not Accepted:

- Plastic bags, motor oil bottles, butter tubs, lids
- Foil, pie tins, paint cans, aerosol cans
- Mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, cups, ceramics
- Plastic appliances – coffee pots, phones, toasters
- Flower pots, toys, cups, buckets, pails
- Plastic deli or bakery containers
- Styrofoam and egg cartons
- Plastic bags and bubble wrap

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard boxes have a “waffle” layer.
No single layer boxes - cereal boxes, tissue boxes, shoe boxes.

NEWSPAPER

Place all newspaper items in a brown paper bag or tie in bundles with cotton string.

MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, AND PHONEBOOKS

No hard or soft cover books.

OFFICE PAPER

- White or light colored paper and envelopes, unwanted (junk) mail.
- Computer and fax paper.
- Notebook paper, index cards, and note cards.
