The following recyclables will be collected: plastic with number 1 or 2 recyclable symbols; CLEAN green, brown or clear glass jars & bottles & tin & aluminum cans; & newspapers tied or in a container. Cardboard must be flattened & tied or in a container.

Newspapers in plastic bags will not be collected. If dirty or unacceptable items are placed in the curbside container, the ENTIRE container will be left at curb. Workers will not return to pick up these containers. We MUST enforce these regulations to continue to provide this free service. Miss your pickup day? The drop off site (at the top of Blanchard Street) is open M-F 7-1:30 for recyclables ONLY!
